Current operation situation

The gushing springs are harnessed by a well (less than 2-m deep) which has been feeding the Ear, Nose and Throat Department of the thermal station. The station was renovated by its new private owner in 2000.

Flow improvement prospects

The flow can be improved by:

- Cleaning and stripping the bottom of the source catchment and extending the collection surface area.
- Deepening by few centimetres the well of the existing catchment pool.

The three springs of Hammam Bourguiba are 15 km west of Ain Drahim, near the border between Tunisia and Algeria.
