Hammam Bourguiba High Spring

Current operation situation

The gushing springs are harnessed by a small pool which has been feeding the Ear, Nose and Throat Department of the thermal station.

Since the works undertaken to improve the catchment in 2003-2004, the surface area of the collection and the flow have increased.

History of catchment and flow

- Before 2003, the gushing springs of the high source were harnessed by a small basin with a flow of 0.6 l/s.

- The three springs of Hammam Bourguiba are 15 km west of Ain Drahim, near the border between Tunisia and Algeria (500m).
