Current operation situation

*The borehole, which is managed by an association of collective interest, feeds a new traditional Hammam with two pools for collective use.

Catchment improvement prospects

- 1- Operation of the existing Boulâaba thermal water borehole:
- Flow varying between 30 and 50 l/s (max 4320m³/day continuous pumping).
- Temperature at 48°C.
- The existing borehole depth is 54m.
- 2- Developing a borehole that is not too deep:
- Important flow
- Temperature lower than 48°C (mixed water).
- Depth between 100m to 150m.
- 3- Developing a deep borehole:
- Depth between 1350m et 1400m.
- Temperature at 60°C.

* The Hammam of Sidi Boulâaba is accessed by a 650-m track that links the Kasserine road to the mail GP23 road linking Kasserine and Thala.
